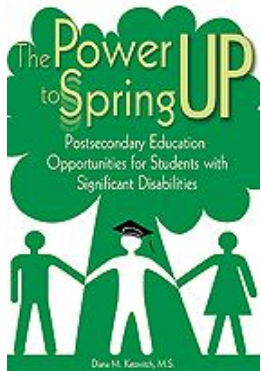


About the Speaker
